- Achieve 80% of Yr 3 & 5 students attaining MSS (Mean Scale Score) \geq the nation in NAPLAN Reading.

Our initiatives include


- Embedding short-term data cycles, including monitoring and analysis, to inform best practice in the teaching of Reading.
- Developing staff capacity by embedding the Instructional Coaching Cycle (co-plan, co-teach, co-reflect, co-assess) in English.
- Developing a whole school Literacy approach to support the teaching of reading across all learning areas.
- Increasing professional engagement through focused professional development in the areas of reading comprehension, decoding strategies and the Early Levelled Reading 4-lesson sequence.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Develop Teacher capacity around the teaching of reading via Professional Development | \$2000 |
| • Enrol Year 3 & 5 and Year 2 & 4 students in Impact Projects (Mind Reader) delivered by Brisbane School of Distance Education. | \$5750 |
| • Employ an additional teacher aide to assist with Reading intervention and learning support | \$8585 |
